- The focus of the position is on independent, applied empirical economic research.
- The position is integrated into the structures of WIFO. We encourage active participation in the research activities of WIFO and FIW. Furthermore, WIFO is eager to support the dissertation project, an open and constructive exchange with the colleagues and consultants of WIFO and the network of FIW is possible and desired.

What you need

- Completed diploma or master's degree in social sciences with a focus on economics or a comparable degree program
- Knowledge of economic theory as well as a documented interest in theoretically based empirical work,
- Very good methodological skills (data science, mathematics, statistics, econometrics),
- Experience with relevant software (including R, Eviews, Stata, Matlab, LaTeX).
- Ability to work independently in a scientific manner.

We offer a 30 hrs/week position. The salary corresponds to the FWF rate for doctoral candidates of currently 2.300,30 € gross per year. WIFO seeks to increase the share of women in research and thus strongly encourages female candidates to apply. In case of equal qualification, the female candidate will be given preference.
